

## Rules of the Wheelbeero Event

The aim of the Wheelbeero Event is for everyone to have fun. To achieve this, remember one overriding rule and you can't go far wrong:

**Ensure you look after yourself, team members, other teams, spectators, Marshals and Stewards.**

Three reasons why you will not be able to take part:

1. All team members must be 18 years of age or older. If you look younger, please be able to show a photo identification "proof of age" document. Stewards have a legal responsibility to ensure you are 18 or over. Please make their job as easy as possible.  
Do not assist anyone under 18 years of age to enter the event.
2. All team members must ensure they are medically fit enough to complete the route. Having a medical condition does not necessarily exclude entry, but when registering, we would ask that you inform the First Aid team of any possible risks. If you fall ill during the event, it's crucial for First Aid personal to react as quickly as possible. Knowing if you have medical conditions such as asthma; allergies; reactions to certain medication etc can be critical.
3. All team members must be sober at the point of entering the event. Those deemed to be over intoxicated will be turned away. Please don't spoil a good night by drinking heavily before the event.

**So, you're able to enter – great!**

Registration will be at the Bouverie Hall, Pewsey on Thursday the 21<sup>st</sup> September between 17.00 and 19.00

### **The Rules**

- A team is made up of three people and one barrow. (For groups of more than 3 see the section: "Things to know about Wheelbeero")
- When moving, you must always remain in control of your barrow.
- Never abandon your barrow. At the end of the event ensure it is returned to your home
- When registering, each team member will be given a coloured wristband (pink, yellow or green). These must be attached to the wrist before leaving the hall. Each Beer Stop's signage will denote a colour. The corresponding member with that colour wristband should consume one pint of beer. There are nine stops, so three pints of beers per team member. There will be pints of water or lemonade provided as an alternative.
- As this is not a race against other teams there is no need to drink the beer at speed. There is no restriction on a team completing the route as quickly as they wish, but to reduce the risk of collision, these teams will start the event first.
- Due to new legislation, generators are no longer allowed, but barrows can be illuminated using batteries.
- This event cannot take place without the hard work of the volunteers. All team members have a responsibility to comply with requests or instructions from Marshals and Stewards and to assist them in their duties where possible and it safe to do so.

Wheelbeero Event Disclaimer

- I declare that I shall abide by the rules of the Event.
- I am not under 18 years old.
- I accept that the organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage, action, claim, cost or expenses, which may arise as a consequence of my participation in this event.
- I declare that I agree with the terms and conditions of event entry and will not take part in this event unless I am in good health on the day of the event and that in any case I will only partake at my own risk.
- I declare that I will abide by PADFAC's rules and the directions as instructed by the organiser's representatives.
- I understand that the organisers reserve the right to delay or cancel the event should adverse weather conditions or other circumstances outside of the organisers' control, pose an unacceptable risk to the participants. Entry fees are non-refundable, even in the event of cancellation.
- You agree that we may publish photographs of you, as a part of promoting the event. This may include photos requested by the press.
- In line with the published rules of the event, I will make First Aid personnel aware of any medical conditions I believe relevant.
