Our aim and the aim of all the Event Organisers, the participants and the volunteers is to do just that.

So, once again, I encourage you all to help us make a success of Carnival on its 125th Anniversary. In addition help us raise vital funds for our two main charities WAA and Prospect Hospice. If you are already involved with some aspect of the Events, thank you. If you have already put yourself forward as a Volunteer, thank you. Raising Money for Charity

Behind all the hard work and fun Pewsey Carnival has always raised money for local charities. 125 years ago, at the first Carnival, funds were raised for Savernake Hospital. This years money raised will be split between a number of small donations to local groups but also two main charities have been chosen



Wiltshire Air Ambulance Charitable Trust is a registered charity providing an essential Helicopter Emergency Medical Service (HEMS) in Wiltshire, Bath and surrounding areas.

We began operating in 1990 and the helicopter and crew have saved countless lives. The charity shared a helicopter with Wiltshire Police for 24 years, but began operating as a stand-alone air ambulance from 2015 using a Bell 429 helicopter:

It costs £4 million a year to keep the lifesaving service operational, which equates to around £11,000 per day.

The charity receives no regular direct funding from the Government or National Lottery grants, so relies on the generous donations from the public and local businesses to raise the vital funds needed.

Prospect Hospice

together making every day count

Since 1980, Prospect Hospice has provided dedicated end-of-life care to local people around the clock, every day of the year.

The charity provides a range of services to support around 1,800 people each year to live independently for as long as possible and cares for people in their own homes as well as in the hospice based in Wroughton.

Care goes beyond providing a nice setting for people to spend their last days and extends to a range of support services including therapy support to assist with breathlessness and fatigue and family support to help with bereavement. All care is tailored to the patient, asking them what matters to them.

All of this is provided free of charge, with no cost to patients or their families, thanks to the generous donations of local people, helping to raise £8million each year to ensure anyone, anywhere can receive outstanding care at the most difficult time.



And here's to Feaste and Carnival in the Pewsey Vale.











