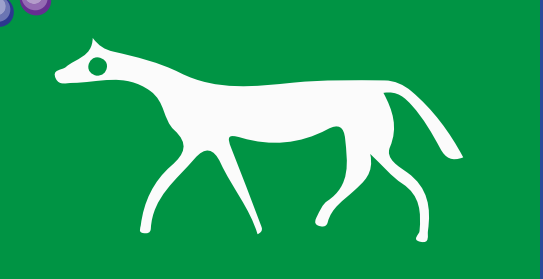

PEWSEY CARNIVAL

THE CHARITIES

Behind all the hard work and fun, Pewsey Carnival has always raised money for local charities. 126 years ago, at the first Carnival, funds were raised for Savernake Hospital.



Since 1980, Prospect Hospice has provided dedicated end-of-life care to local people around the clock, every day of the year. The charity provides a range of services to support around 1,800 people each year to live independently for as long as possible and cares for people in their own homes as well as in the hospice based in Wroughton.

Care goes beyond providing a nice setting for people to spend their last days and extends to a range of support services including therapy support to assist with breathlessness and fatigue and family support to help with bereavement. All care is tailored to the patient, asking them what matters to them, to ensure care is truly personalised. All of this is provided free of charge, with no cost to patients or their families, thanks to the generous donations of local people, helping to raise £8 million each year to ensure anyone, anywhere can receive outstanding care at the most difficult time.

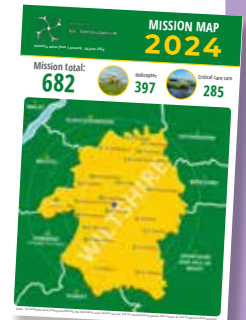


Wiltshire Air Ambulance Charitable Trust is a registered charity providing an essential Helicopter Emergency Medical Service (HEMS) in Wiltshire, Bath and surrounding areas.

We began operating in 1990 and the helicopter and crew have saved countless lives. The charity shared a helicopter with Wiltshire Police for 24 years, but began operating as a stand-alone air ambulance from 2015 using a Bell 429 helicopter.

It costs £4.5 million a year to keep the lifesaving service operational, which equates to more than £12,000 per day.

Our aircrew are operational up to 19 hours a day, every day, and is called to, on average, three incidents a day in its helicopter and two critical care cars.

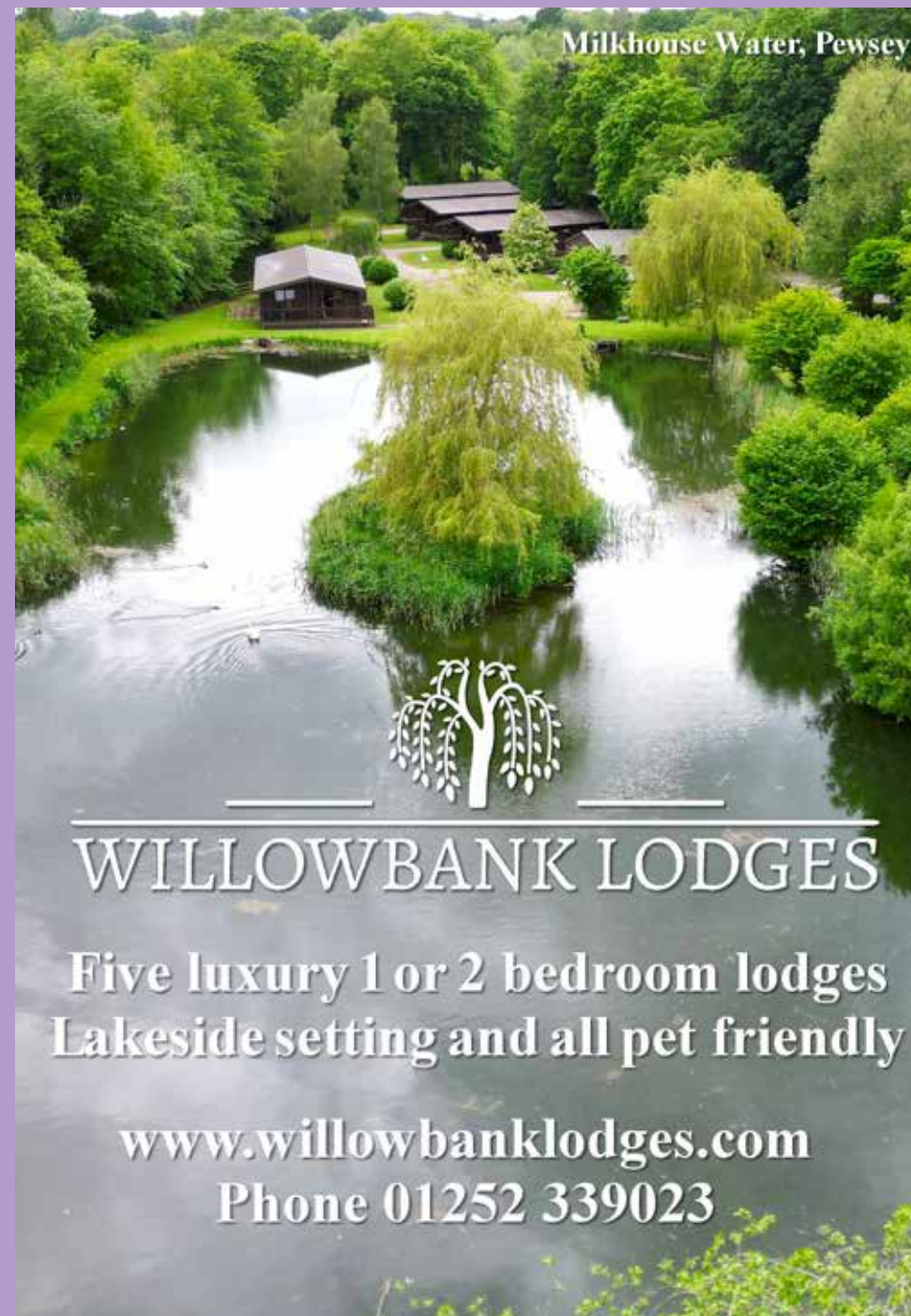

IMPORTANT NOTICE

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE ORDER - TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847

IN ACCORDANCE with Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, which section gives Wiltshire Council ("The Council") the power to make an order for roads within its administrative area to be closed temporarily to all vehicular traffic (and for alternative routes to be observed) for the purposes of preventing obstruction.

- The Crescent (Part), from its junction with Slaters Road to its junction with Church Road.

- B3087 High Street, from its junction with B3087 Market Place to its junction with B3087 Milton Road/ Ball Road.
- Ball Road, from its junction with B3087 High Street to its junction with Southcott Road.

- Slater Road, from its junction with The Crescent to its junction with Rawlins Road
- Rawlins Road (Part), from its junction with Slater Road to its junction with Wilcot Road.
- Wilcot Road (Part), from its junction with Rawlins Road to its junction with North Street.
- B3087 (Part) Market Place, from its junction with A345 Market Place to its junction with High Street.
- B3087 (Part) High Street, from its junction with Market Place to its junction with Milton Road.
- B3087 Milton Road (Part). from its junction with High Street to a point outside Little Ann.
- A345 Swan Road (Part), from its junction with The Crescent to its junction with Salisbury Road.

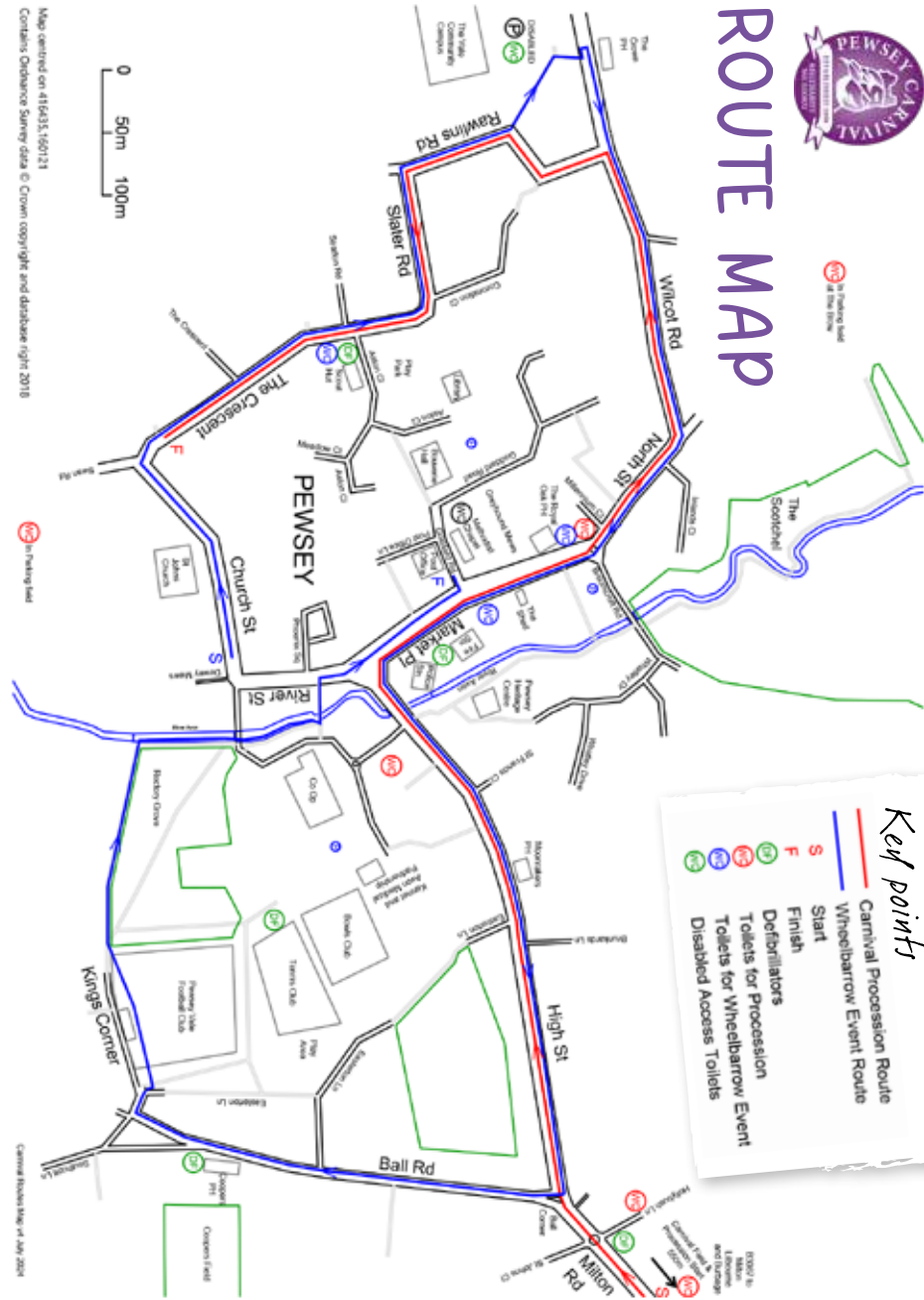

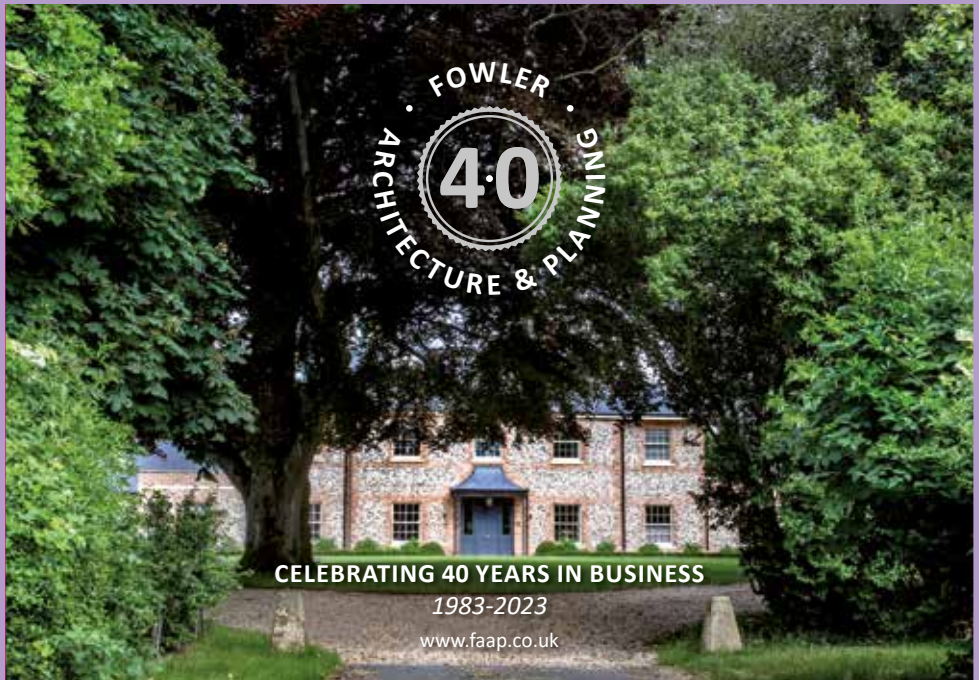
